"National Education Policy & Internship as a Value Education:-Implications For Teachers and Students Education."

The National Education Policy 2020, outlines the vision of India's new education system. The policy recognizes and identifies teachers and faculty as the heart of the learning process. As envisioned by Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi ji, the Policy will empower teachers of India and lists out various reforms for their recruitment, continuous professional development, service conditions, etc. The world is undergoing rapid changes in the knowledge landscape. With various dramatic scientific and technological advances, such as the rise of big data, machine learning, and artificial intelligence, many unskilled jobs worldwide may be taken over by machines, while the need for a skilled workforce, particularly involving mathematics, computer science, and data science, in conjunction with multidisciplinary abilities across the sciences, social sciences, and humanities, will be increasingly in greater demand. With climate change, increasing pollution, and depleting natural resources, there will be a sizeable shift in how we meet the world's energy, water, food, and sanitation needs, again resulting in the need for new skilled labour, particularly in biology, chemistry, physics, agriculture, climate science, and social science. The growing emergence of epidemics and pandemics will also call for collaborative research in infectious disease management and development of vaccines and the resultant social issues heightens the need for multidisciplinary learning. CONCEPT NOTE

Education is fundamental for achieving full human potential, developing an equitable and just society, and promoting national development. Providing universal access to quality education is the key to India's continued ascent, and leadership on the global stage in terms of economic growth, social justice and equality, scientific advancement, national integration, and cultural preservation. Universal highquality education is the best way forward for developing and maximizing our country's rich talents and resources for the good of the individual, the society, the country, and the world. India will have the highest population of young people in the world over the next decade, and our ability to provide highquality educational opportunities to them will determine the future of our country. The global education development agenda reflected in the Goal 4 (SDG4) of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, adopted by India in 2015 - seeks to "ensure inclusive and equitable quality education and promote lifelong learning opportunities for all" by 2030. Such a lofty goal will require the entire education system to be reconfigured to support and foster learning, so that all of the critical targets and goals (SDGs) of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development can be achieved. The world is undergoing rapid changes in the knowledge landscape. With various dramatic scientific and technological advances, such as the rise of big data, machine learning, and artificial intelligence, many unskilled jobs worldwide may be taken over by machines, while the need for a skilled workforce, particularly involving mathematics, computer science, and data science, in conjunction with multidisciplinary abilities across the sciences, social sciences, and humanities, will be increasingly in greater demand. With climate change, increasing pollution, and depleting natural resources, there will be a sizeable shift in how we meet the world's energy, water, food, and sanitation needs, again resulting in the need for new skilled labour, particularly in biology, chemistry, physics, agriculture, climate science, and social science. Indeed, with the quickly changing employment landscape and global ecosystem, it is becoming increasingly critical that children not only learn, but more importantly learn how to learn. Education thus, must move towards less content, and more towards learning about how to think critically and solve problems, how to be creative and multidisciplinary, and how to innovate, adapt, and absorb new material in novel and changing fields. Pedagogy must evolve to make education more experiential, holistic, integrated, inquiry-driven, discovery-oriented, learner-centred, discussion-based, flexible, and, of course, enjoyable. The curriculum must include basic arts, crafts, humanities, games, sports and fitness, languages, literature, culture, and values, in addition to science and mathematics, to develop all aspects and capabilities of learners; and make education more well-rounded, useful, and fulfilling to the learner. Education must build character, enable learners to be ethical, rational, compassionate, and caring, while at the same time prepare them for gainful, fulfilling employment. The gap between the current state of learning outcomes and what is required must be bridged through undertaking major reforms that bring the highest quality, equity, and integrity into the system, from early childhood care and education through higher education. The aim must be for India to have an education system by 2040 that is second to none, with equitable access to the highest-quality education for all learners regardless of social or economic background. This National Education Policy 2020 is the first education policy of the 21st century and aims to address the many growing developmental imperatives of our country. This Policy proposes the revision and revamping of all aspects of the education structure, including its regulation and governance, to create a new system that is aligned with the aspirational goals of 21st century education, including SDG4, while building upon India's traditions and value systems. V. Hall . The conference was inaugurated by Hon. Rajesh Pande who is Member of SPPU MGT Committee and Hon. Krishna Kumar Goyal who is famous Industrialist and Chairman of KES. Hon. Rajesh Pande sir guided participants on "Role of Teachers in NEP 2020". Hon. Krishna Kumar Goyal sir had given valuable speech on "Globalizations and NEP 2020". Total 117 students and teachers participated in national seminar from various states and colleges.

Topic :- Universalization of Education: Internship Program

Our first session speaker Dr. Vrishali Randhir gave detailed insight about internship program. The NEP 2020 lays down the framework for transformational reforms in school and higher education systems in the country. The new policy targets a 100% Gross Enrolment Ratio (GER) in school education in next 10 years (by the year 2030) and also envisions Universalization of education from preschool to secondary level.

The structure of school education has been overhauled with the addition of pre-schooling provision for kids. The policy also aims at increasing the higher education GER to 50% by 2035. The NEP 2020 intends to boost the spending on education by enhancing the education budget to a level of 6% of the GDP. As per the policy document, the Centre and the States will work together to increase the public investment in the Education sector to reach the targeted budget of 6% of GDP at the earliest. The NEP 2020 also brings flexibility for students to choose subjects in place of streams for their higher education. This aims at strengthening the crossfunctional study environment and developing critical thinking amongst students. Also, multiple entry and exit options will be there for students in the form of certificate, diploma and degree during their higher education.

The NEP 2020 has provisions for flexible UG courses with multiple entry and exit options for students. For example, a student can exit just after 1st year of graduation with a certificate in hand. Similarity, an exit option after 2nd year comes with an Advanced Diploma and 3rd year exit will be conferred with a Bachelor's Degree. A new addition is the 4th year of UG programme which comes with a tag of Bachelor's Degree with Research.

The National Education Policy 2020 abolishes multiple regulatory bodies in higher education such as UGC, AICTE etc. Instead, all the existing regulatory bodies, except for those dealing in medical and law education, will come under one umbrella called The Higher Education Commission of India (HECI). This central regulator will have four arms to work on different functions – Regulation, Funding, Standard Setting and Accreditation.

Further, the new policy focuses on providing graded autonomy to affiliated institutions over the next 15 years.

The policy also makes a provision for a central body which will work on online learning options and enhance the use of technology in higher education so that it becomes more accessible for masses and also remain in sync with the evolving needs of students.



The NEP 2020 has proposed to set up an autonomous body – the **National Educational Technology Forum** (**NETF**), to provide a platform for free exchange of ideas on the use of technology in order to enhance learning, assessment, planning, and administration.

The National Education Policy has also emphasized on setting up of a **Gender Inclusion Fund** which is aimed at creating an environment of equitable and fair quality education for girls as well as transgender students. Also, as per the NEP document, Special Education Zones will be created for disadvantaged regions and groups which will make higher education opportunities more accessible for students.

National Education Policy 2020 has emphasised the use of technology in multiple ways to enhance the teaching-learning experience and also to make quality education accessible for masses. As per the NEP document, the use of technology will be taken to the next level to "ensure preparedness with alternative modes of quality education whenever and wherever traditional and in-person modes of education are not possible." This step carries special significance in the backdrop of the COVID 19 pandemic, forcing the majority of institutions to switch their teaching-learning mode from in-person offline method to virtual learning in online mode.

To promote 'Online Education and Digital Education', a dedicated unit will be set up to facilitate building of digital infrastructure, digital content and also to look after the e-education needs at the level of both school and higher education.

Further, under the 'Open and Distance Learning' will be made more relevant with credit-based recognition of Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs) to make these courses at par with the highest quality in-class programmes.

The government will also set up an autonomous body – National Educational Technology Forum (NETF), which will work as a platform for free exchange of ideas on the use of technology to enhance learning, assessment, planning, and administration.

One of the most important and needed task to do in today's world is to ensure the sustainability of the resources the planet has and at the same time to ensure the well-being of humans living on this planet. Schools curriculum have been designed over the years from the perspective of sustainable education but it has to be implemented in an effective manner.

The 'Sustainable Development Goal 4' (SDG4) advocates for high-quality education for all, which is rooted in a number of international declarations, including the 'Universal Declaration of Human Rights,' 'Convention on the Rights of the Child,' 'World Declaration on Education for All,' 'Dakar Framework for Action,' and the 'Millennium Development Goals,' and thus sees education as vital to the well-being of individuals, nations. The SDG 4 aims at providing universal and equal education to all and it is closely linked with the effective implementation of all other 16 global goals. SDG 4 advocates to 'ensure inclusive and equitable quality education and promote lifelong learning opportunities for all' and it has the following targets; Ensure that all girls and boys receive a free, equitable, and high-quality primary and secondary education that results in relevant and effective learning outcomes by 2030. Ensure that all girls and boys have access to high-quality early childhood development, care, and pre-primary education by 2030 in order to be prepared for primary school; Ensure that all women and men have equitable access to cheap and high-quality technical, vocational, and postsecondary education, including university, by 2030. By 2030, remove gender gaps in education and ensure that the vulnerable, including individuals with disabilities, indigenous peoples, and children in

precarious situations, have equitable access to all levels of education and vocational training. Ensure that all young people and a significant number of adults, both men and women, are literate and numerate by 2030. Ensure that all learners acquire the knowledge and skills needed to promote sustainable development by 2030, including through education for sustainable development and sustainable lifestyles, human rights, gender equality, promotion of a culture of peace and nonviolence, global citizenship, and appreciation of cultural diversity and culture's contribution to sustainable development, among other things. Bringing education as a powerful tool, it can improve the standard of living and quality of life of citizens by generating employment opportunities for the youth, providing safety for women, protecting the environment, providing education to all age groups, reducing dropout rates, etc.

- 4. **Research Methodology:** The seminar covered various research methodologies and their applicability to different types of research questions. Prof. Mehnaz discussed the importance of selecting the right methodology for one's study and explained how to justify the choice.
- 5. **Data Collection and Analysis:** Practical guidance on data collection methods and tools were provided. Prof. Mehnaz shared insights into data analysis techniques, including software applications commonly used in research.
- 6. **Structuring the Paper:** She highlighted the typical structure of a research paper, including the introduction, literature review, methodology, results, discussion, and conclusion. Students were given templates and examples to guide their paper organization.
- 7. Writing Style and Citations: Prof. Mehnaz emphasized the importance of clear and concise writing. She discussed citation styles such as APA, MLA, and Chicago and demonstrated how to avoid plagiarism.
- 8. **Peer Review and Proofreading:** Students were encouraged to seek peer review and edit their papers rigorously. Prof. Mehnaz provided strategies for proofreading and improving the overall quality of the paper.
- 9. **Submitting to Conferences:** The seminar concluded with a detailed discussion of the submission process. Prof. Mehnaz explained how to prepare an abstract, adhere to submission deadlines, and communicate effectively with conference organizers.

Conclusion

The seminar conducted by Prof. Mehnaz Kaushar on "How to Write Research Papers for National and International Conferences" was a valuable learning experience for SYBBA and TYBBA students. It equipped them with the knowledge and skills necessary to embark on their research paper writing journey effectively. The seminar not only addressed the technical aspects of research paper

preparation but also instilled confidence in the students to contribute meaningfully to their respective fields of study.
