# "Role of Hostel in the Development of Urban area: an Outlook of various Universities in Pune City"

### Abstract:

In India many revolutionary people like Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar, Mahatma Jyotiroa Phule, Savitibai Phule, Dnyanmutri Ranade and Ramabai Ranade, Maharshi Dr. Anna Karve all these people gave importance to education. Today, in Pune city Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar govt. hostel is known for caste category students There is also Sevasaden hostel of Ramabai Ranade and Mahila Ashram Vasatigruha (hostel) of Mahasrhi Dr. Anna Karve in karve nagar, Pune. There is also SNDT university hostel of Mahashri Dr. Anna Karve. The economic development concept includes - Age limit, health service, education, increase in the standard of living. Everyone has right to get education and freedom to choose the field of education. Hostel is a good opportunity for staying and getting education. In this way hostels are related to economic development.

In India, rural area is undeveloped, and there the financial situation of people is weak. Here there is no proper and enough education system for primary to higher education, technical and medical education. So students move from rural to urban area for education and then they get good job or placement in city area.

### **Definition of Hostel-**

"Hostel means where the student live together under one shelter take food together and follow particular rules and regulation in the Hostel."

### Hypothesis:

### **Objectives of Study:**

 To understand and evaluate the role of various university's hostels in students development. • To enhance the social status of different caste category wise students enrolled in universities hostels.

### Research Methodology:

Primary data has been used in this paper. Direct written interviews of hostel students were taken through the questionnaire .Secondary data has been taken from my PhD study, news paper and internet.

### Role of Hostel:

Those students also are financially strong or from rich family they get admission in private hostels. In rural area backward caste students want to get education, they try to get admission in government hostels, government charge them nominal cost. College students and students doing any subject or field research study and stay in private or government university hostel.

In Pune city most popular universities are SNDT women university, Savitribai Phule Pune University, (SPPU), Bharati university and Tilak Maharashtra university. SNDT Women University and Pune University are government grantable. Both universities provide hostels in their campus. They charge very nominal amount. Hostel follows rules and regulations of govt. for admission, reservation quota, fees, food etc. Here selected students come from different categories like OBC,SC,ST,NT,PWD etc. and they are from poor families belonging to rural areas of Maharashtra and outside of Maharashtra.

### S.N.D.T. Women's University:

The university is for only women. University has its own reputation among all universities. It was established in 1916. It is located near Karve road. Most of the students in university come from rural area and Pune city. The university provide higher education and research programs. Nearly 450-460 students will take admission in hostel.

Savitribai Phule Pune University, (SPPU),

It is well known as Pune University. It was established in 1948. It is spread in 411 acre area in the Pune city. It is one of the best Universities in India. University is well known for its research in science and arts field. University has forty Departments. Admission process in the university is based on merit and category reservation base. It provides education to the students at very nominal cost. Every year students from abroad and other states take admission in the university.

### Bharati University

Bharati University has been established in Erandawne and Katraj area of Pune City. The university has Hostel Facility. The hostel provides basic amenities like Study table, chair,cot, Fan, Xerox machine and hospital facilities to the students. The university gives admission

on the basis of merit instead of Caste category. Student should fulfil merit and financial criteria of the University.

### Tilak Maharashtra Vidyapeeth:

Tilak Maharashtra Vidyapeeth provides hostel facility to the students who take admission in the University. Students have to pay fees for accommodation and Mess. Hostel admission is not based on Category or merit. Hostel admission is given on first come first serve basis.

Above Table shows that, In SNDT women university girls belonging to all categories live together. Boys and girls belonging to all categories live in their own separate buildings in the Pune university hostel campus. In Bharati University and Tilak Maharashtra University boys and girls belonging to only open category were taken admissions. There is no reservation for backward category.

Above Table no 2 shows, 89.72% urban area population is educated compared to 87.86% rural area educated population. Male literacy rate is 92.45% compared to female literacy rate 86.80%. It is not equal.

### Conclusion

- Pune city has many colleges and universities, there is big opportunity for education but students have problem of residence. In this case Govt, hostel is a very good option for financially poor students and students from outside of Pune city belonging to backward categories.
- Literacy rate of male and female is not equal. Literacy rate of male is more than female.
- No reservations system for admission in the Bharati University and Tilak Maharashtra University and in their hostels.
- Pune city has separate colleges and universities for women.

### Suggestion

- University should increase the hostels campus, room for students, etc,so that more student can get opportunity for education.
- University should increase the number of seats for backward students or category students.
- Government, NGO's and kind people should make financial support policy for those students who have financial problems.
