1.1 BUSINESS ETHICS - MEANING, DEFINITIONS

Ethics derives from the Greek word "ethos" meaning "character" and is also known as moral philosophy, which is a branch of philosophy that involves "systematizing, defending and recommending concepts of right and wrong conduct." Ethics involves understanding the differences between right and wrong thinking and actions, and using principled decision making to choose actions that do not hurt others. Although intuition and creativity are often involved in having to decide between what seems like two "wrong" or less desirable choices in a dilemma where there are no easy alternatives, using ethical principles to inform our thinking before acting hastily may reduce the negative consequences of our actions.

Peter F. Drucker writes – "There is only one ethics, one set of rules of morality, one code that of individual behaviour in which the same rules apply to everyone alike.

"Philip Wheel Wright says - "Ethics is the branch of philosophy which is the systematic study of selective choice, of the standards of right and wrong and by which it may ultimately be directed.
